SMILE-Center provides funding for battery powered ride-on cars to be modified by Madonna Rehabilitation Hospital, GoBabygo! chapters, and area physical therapists for children with mobility challenges. The little cars provide mobility that greatly increases learning and independence at an early age. Funds raised will allow SMILE-Center to donate more cars to children in need.

Branched Oak Observatory (branedoakobservatory.com) is a family-oriented astronomical observing site near (but not inside) the Branched Oak Recreation Area, 23 miles northwest of Lincoln. It is supported by science education professionals and astronomy enthusiasts who give their valuable time and expertise to the growing facility. The observatory will benefit by helping to fund the purchase of a new cutting-edge telescope and mount as well as to increase outreach to the community at large.
